Intellectual Property Rights, IP related Convention for Protection of Industrial Property 1967-1989 .26th April Celebrated as world IP Day. IP related laws and convention ,Threats in the period of patent i.e window period for the owners. Every act with its valid duration, Protection given under copy rights; Two Rights economic & moral rights granted to creator, provision for registration, protection given under trade marks to symbols, brand heading label, name, signature, word, phrase, letter symbol, image, designs, number, logo which are valid for 10 years. Process should be industry applicable valid for 20 years. Protection given under Industry Designs, granted for shape, configuration and pattern of ornament or aesthetic aspect of an article.

Protection given under geographical indications, granted for products originating in a country or territory valid for 10 years. Confidential information, factors protected under copyrights, duration is generally 60 years after the death of the owner. Fair use Factors, highlighted the fair use on the basis of purpose, character, nature amount of portion, and the affect of the use upon the potential. Dr. Praveen Badade also elaborated the Concept of DMCA(1998) Digital Millennium Copyright Act. Patent known as industrial property is an agreement between an inventor and a country. Importance, usefulness, legal aspects of Patents, types of patent, Criteria for patenting, what is not patentable, how to file patent, status of Indian patents in global scenario, Indian Trends in IPR in graphical statistics were discussed by the Resource Person. Valuable examples of Patents is Commerce and business were disclosed during the workshop.
