Staff Training programme on "Ethical Hacking" was organized by Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's C. D. Jain College of Commerce, Shrirampur and Sponsered by IQAC on 10th October 2014. The Inaugaral session of this programme was chaired by IQAC chairman Principal Dr.Bhor L.D (Principal ,C.D. Jain College of Commerce, Shrirampur) ,Chief guest Dr .Barhate G.H (Head, Research Center , C.D.Jain College of Commerce, Shrirampur.) and Resource Person Mr.Manojkumar Langote (Head, Computer Department ,PIRENS Institute ,Loni).Total 28 Staff attended this training Programme.

Introduction of the dignitaries was given by Prof.Chandratre Y.V. Dr.Bhor mentioned in his key address that "As the old adage goes "Prevention is better than cure" this is what exactly describes the purpose of ethical hacking"

Mr.Manojkumar Started his session with the brief introduction about 'Why we need to understand what the Hacking is?' He continued his session with the various types of hackers and covered the necessity of hats and security hackers.

He mainly focuses on the people eager to be a White Hat Hacker. It features a brief introduction to the world of hacking starting with the importance of *ethical hackers* and their need in today's world scenario, including to the basics of Networking that will help you have a deep understanding of the working of internet.

At the end of his session he explained The Internet is still growing and e-commerce is on its advance. More and more computers get connected to the Internet, wireless devices and networks are booming and sooner or later, nearly every electronic device may have its own IP address. The complexity of networks is increasing, the software on devices gets more complicated and user friendly. Therefore, Security is a hot topic and quite some effort is spend in securing services, systems and networks. On the internet, there is a silent war going on between the good and the bad guys. between the ones who are trying hard to keep information secured and the ones who are trying to get prohibited access to this information. Securing an information technology environment does not just consist of a bunch of actions which can be taken and then everything can be forgotten. There is no fire and forget solution.
